It was also noted existing town infrastructure is incapable of supporting this development.

That the recommendation of the Planning and Traffic Committee be accepted and Outline Planning Permission be denied in accordance with the provisions of Section 11 of the General Regulations in the Stephenville Development Regulations, that being the proposed development does not comply with the aesthetics of the neighbourhood, the narrow street is not adequate for increased traffic and congestion on the street would be of public safety, subject to conditions as outlined in the agenda data. It was also noted existing town infrastructure is incapable of supporting this development.
