Mayor Rose

He mentioned that he attended the opening night of the 46th Stephenville Theatre Festival and praised everyone involved, saying it was one of the best performances he had ever seen. This year over 600 applicants from across the world applied to work at the theatre festival; that is a testimonial to our arts community, the Stephenville Theatre Festival and our town. Also, he attended another great event hosted by the Friendly Invasion "Night at the Museum", with Councillor Hynes as MC.

He praised the Beautification Committee for their excellent work in keeping our town well-groomed.
